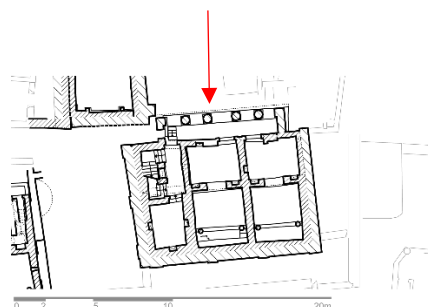

Decoration	Front hall: wall paintings with fighting animals (lost today). 1 st room: imitation of <i>opus sectile</i> . 2 nd room: baldachin with columns and imitation of cloth with red fruit on green background at the back wall.
