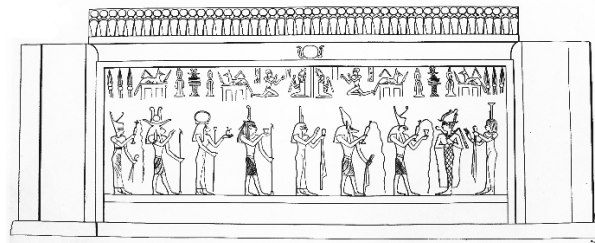
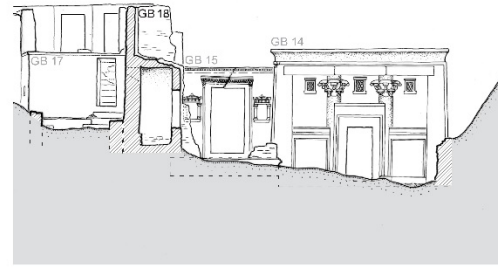

Relief of the tomb enclosure

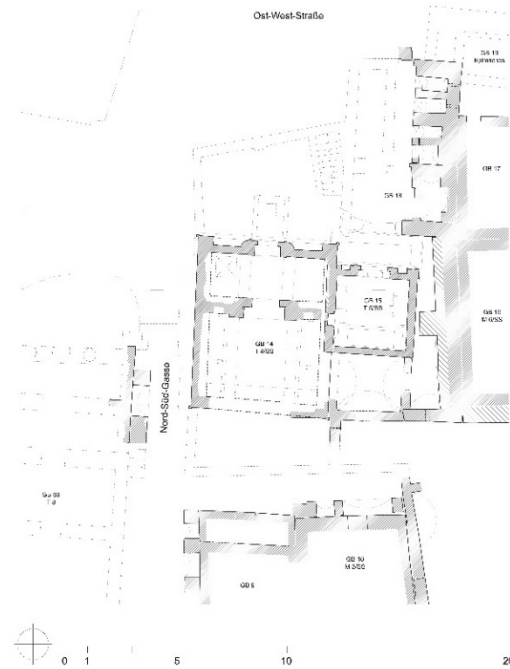

Local limestone ('Muschelkalk'); the ceiling was probably built with mud bricks

Number of burials

At least 3 (tomb enclosure, two burials in the floor)

Number of floors	1 on a podium
Number of rooms	1
Number of niches	2 in the western wall (used for urns or canopies?)
Decoration	Façade: Greek ornaments in Ionic (door frame) and Doric-Corinthian style (frames of the niches) Inside: Tomb enclosure with an Egyptian relief
Inscriptions	None; inside was found a stela of Pa-Isis (Cairo University Museum (inv. no. 1609)
