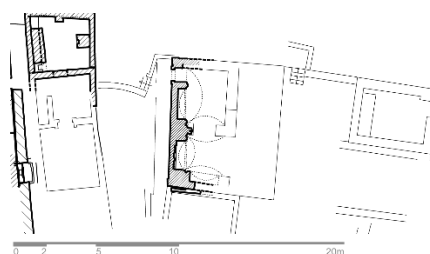

Construction material	Local limestone (1 st floor) and mudbrick (2 nd floor)

Number of niches	Unknown (only the western part of the 1 st floor is preserved)
Decoration	1 st floor: Corinthian columns, wall paintings with Dionysian motives (thyrsos, masks, face of a maenad); on the left sidewall ornamental paintings imitating rectangular tiles
