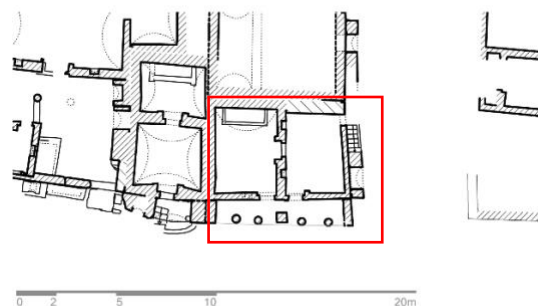


GB 5 (no Gabra no.)



Date of construction	1st floor: 1st century AD? 2nd floor: 2nd or 3rd century AD
Name of the deceased	Unknown
Construction material	Mudbrick
Number of burials	Unknown
Number of floors	2? (2nd floor destroyed except the staircase)
Number of rooms	2 plus front hall (1st floor)
Number of niches	None

GB 5 (no Gabra no.)

Decoration	1 st floor, front hall: two columns <i>in antis</i> in front of each entrance (destroyed); western room: wall paintings imitating garlands, funerary bed (later addition) with floral decoration and imitation of a mattress; eastern room: not preserved
